WHAT IS THE NCSRT

The North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists, Inc., established in 1939, is the professional society for registered Radiologic Technologists. The society gives health care professionals the knowledge, resources, and support they need to provide quality patient care.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership is based on persons involvement in the radiologic sciences.

•**Voting members** consist of the following:

ACTIVE: individuals who hold an active certificate and are in good standing with American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT), Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonography (RDMS), or the Nuclear Medicine Technology Certification Board (NMTCB).

INACTIVE: individuals who hold an active certificate and are in good standing with ARRT, ARDMS, or NMTCB but are not employed.

ADVANCED STUDENT: members enrolled in a full time program of advanced study in the radiologic sciences.

LIFE: members who have given extraordinary service to the North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists, Inc. These members are selected by a majority vote.

RETIRED: members who are no longer actively engaged in the radiologic sciences and have applied and received retired status with ARRT.

•**Non voting members** consist of the following:

STUDENT: students enrolled in an educational program accredited by the Joint Review Commission on Education or the equivalent.

HONORARY: members who the society wishes to honor because of their involvement and interests in the North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists, Inc. These members are chosen by a majority vote.

COMMERCIAL: members involved in commercial support services.

SUPPORTING: individuals who demonstrate an interest in the radiologic sciences.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

Technological advances and the increasing complexity of patient care techniques and procedures have radically altered the healthcare field in the past several years. Continuing education hours (CE's) are offered to all members 2 times a year and at Annual Conference. This helps members maintain their ARRT registration by satisfying their CE requirements.

The North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists, Inc. Annual Conference includes cutting edge educational opportunities as well as exhibits displaying the latest in technology.

Rainbow educational meetings are one day seminars held 2 times a year throughout North Carolina.
