“For more than 2 years the Board of Directors discussed how to best address this issue. There was no solution that pleased everyone. Each Board member felt that 25 years of service to the profession was certainly worthy of recognition and yet we were unable to come up with a mechanism to ensure that EVERY MEMBER who was eligible would be recognized.

These awards were given in recognition of 25 years of service to the profession and were presented to qualified members (based upon the award guidelines) during the 26th year following graduation from an approved program. CHAPTER 16

NORTH CAROLINA AFFILIATE DELEGATES TO THE ANNUAL MEETINGS OF THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF X-RAY TECHNICIANS

Each affiliate had the right to be represented at the annual conventions of the American Society of X-Ray Technicians. To that end, the affiliate society appointed a delegate and an alternate delegate to represent their state. Early in the history of the NCSXT it was customary to select someone who was going to the meeting. There was no financial help given from the state.

North Carolina applied for affiliate status in 1940, but was denied due to the lack of members holding certification in the American Registry of X-Ray Technicians. Officers had to be certified and we only had four (4) members meeting the requirement of twenty-five (25) members. In 1941 the society voted to drop the application for membership until the requirements could be met.

In 1944 the society refilled application for membership and in 1945 NCSXT was accepted as an affiliate of the ASXT, and received their Charter. The first NCSXT official delegate attended the 1946 ASXT meeting in St. Louis.

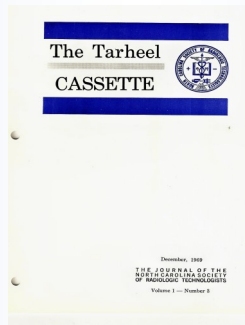
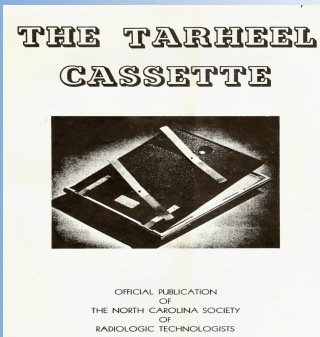

The early history of the North Carolina publication was plagued by lack of resources, and a name vexed the best of editors. Membership was small, and dues in the society did not produce enough funds to support printing on a regular basis. Additionally, the membership did not submit enough information to make up an issue.

We are proud to honor the editors and their staff, who for sixty-nine years, in spite of all the adversities, have given us an avenue of communication, with the final development, The Tarheel Cassette, and The Tarheel Technology Highlights. From circa 1949 until 1983 The Tarheel Cassette was the official publication of the North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists Inc. and the Highlights was a supplement. In 1983 it was decided that the Cassette and/or the Highlights would be the official publication(s).

Notice how the publications have morphed into a sophisticated look, due to the forward vision of the Editors. You will note that credentials are not listed due to inconstancy of accurate documentation.

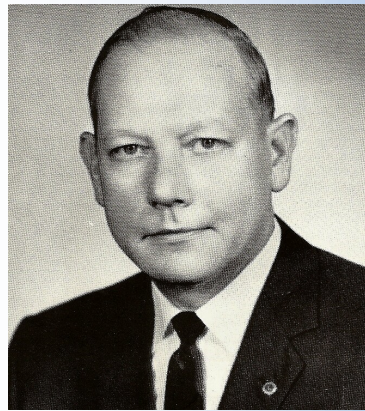

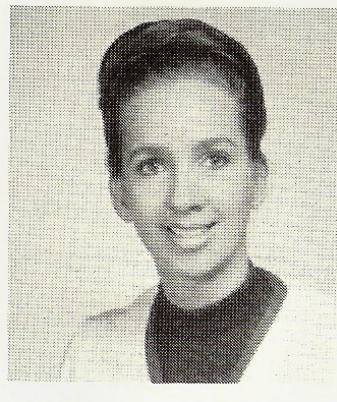
